CONTINGENT LEADERS' MEETING

Date: Saturday, 11th July, 2026

Time: 11:00 am

Venue: Main Auditorium, Jamnabai Narsee School, Mumbai.

- Briefing of all events along with any additions/deletions/changes will be intimated at this meeting.
- All details with regards to the registration process will be explained and the unique username and password will be provided for the same.
- **All schools wishing to participate in Cascade 31 must send their representatives (Contingent Leader, Assistant Contingent Leader and 2 Teachers-In-Charge) for this meeting.**

GENERAL RULES

- The reporting time on 22nd and 23rd August, 2026, is 7:30 am.
- The entire contingent must report together at 7:30 am on the respective days. No participant will be allowed to enter the school premises during the course of the day. **ONLY** students of **STD. 1 and 2** will be permitted to enter the school **1 hour** prior to the scheduled time of their events. The Teacher-In-Charge should be present at the time of entry.
- Upon arrival, the Teachers-In-Charge and the Contingent Leaders will be required to report to the administration department to confirm their attendance. **Each contingent must carry 2 attested copies of Entry Form No. 2** with the stamp of the school and the Principal's signature.
- Each contingent will be assigned a waiting area during the days of Cascade 31.
- **No member of the contingent (Participant/Non-Participant) shall enter Cascade 31 in their school uniform/jersey.**
- **Participants must NOT reveal their school's identity during the course of Cascade 31. Each school will be provided with a unique Cascade Contingent Code (CC Code) which can be used for identification purposes.**
- Every participant should report for the individual event registration, at the respective venues, at least **30 minutes** prior to the scheduled time of the event with the Teacher-In-Charge/Contingent Leader.
Please note: Registration for all Sports Mania events will be **1 Hour** prior to the scheduled time of the event.

- Participants should refer to the **SCHEDULE** for detailed timings before entering their names for multiple events. We advise keeping a gap of at least 2 hours between the end of one event and the start of another.

Kindly note that the schedule is subject to change on the day of the event.

- Every participant must have a **valid Cascade Identity Card** in order to participate. Each ID card must have the participant's photograph, along with the stamp of the school and the Principal's signature across it.
- ID Cards for teachers must be attested in the same way as the Participant ID Cards. **No extra ID Cards will be issued.**
- A maximum of **8 teachers** may accompany the contingent on each day.
- **Non-Participant and Parent Passes** will be available for sale on the days of the events i.e. **22nd and 23rd August, 2026.**
- **All Passes are for entry into the school premises on the days of Cascade 31. Entry into individual venues will strictly be on a FIRST COME FIRST SERVE BASIS. Right of admission is reserved.**
- Participants must carry their own material/equipment for all events unless mentioned otherwise.
- **The Judges' decision for all events of Cascade 31 shall be final, binding and not subject to questioning.**
- **Disciplinary action will be taken against students indulging in any kind of misconduct/vandalism. In either/both cases, the school will be penalized.**

- It is **mandatory** for a representative of each contingent to be present at the **Closing Ceremony on Sunday, 23rd August, 2026, 05:00 pm** in the Main Auditorium to receive the trophies/certificates on behalf of their contingent.
- The point system will be followed as below:

First Place	20 points
Second Place	15 points
Third Place	10 points
Participation	02 points
- In the event of a tie, both teams will be awarded the same number of points.
- 2 points** will be **deducted for absenteeism** from each event.
- Absenteeism **ONLY** refers to the situation of a contingent registering for an event but failing to participate in the same. This is different from non-participation where a school has not registered for the event. No marks will be deducted for non-participation.
- A contingent can avoid negative marking for absenteeism by informing the administration department upon arrival in the morning **OR** having a non-participant or another participant substitute for an absentee by reporting to the venue of the event **with the Teacher-In-Charge/Contingent Leader**.

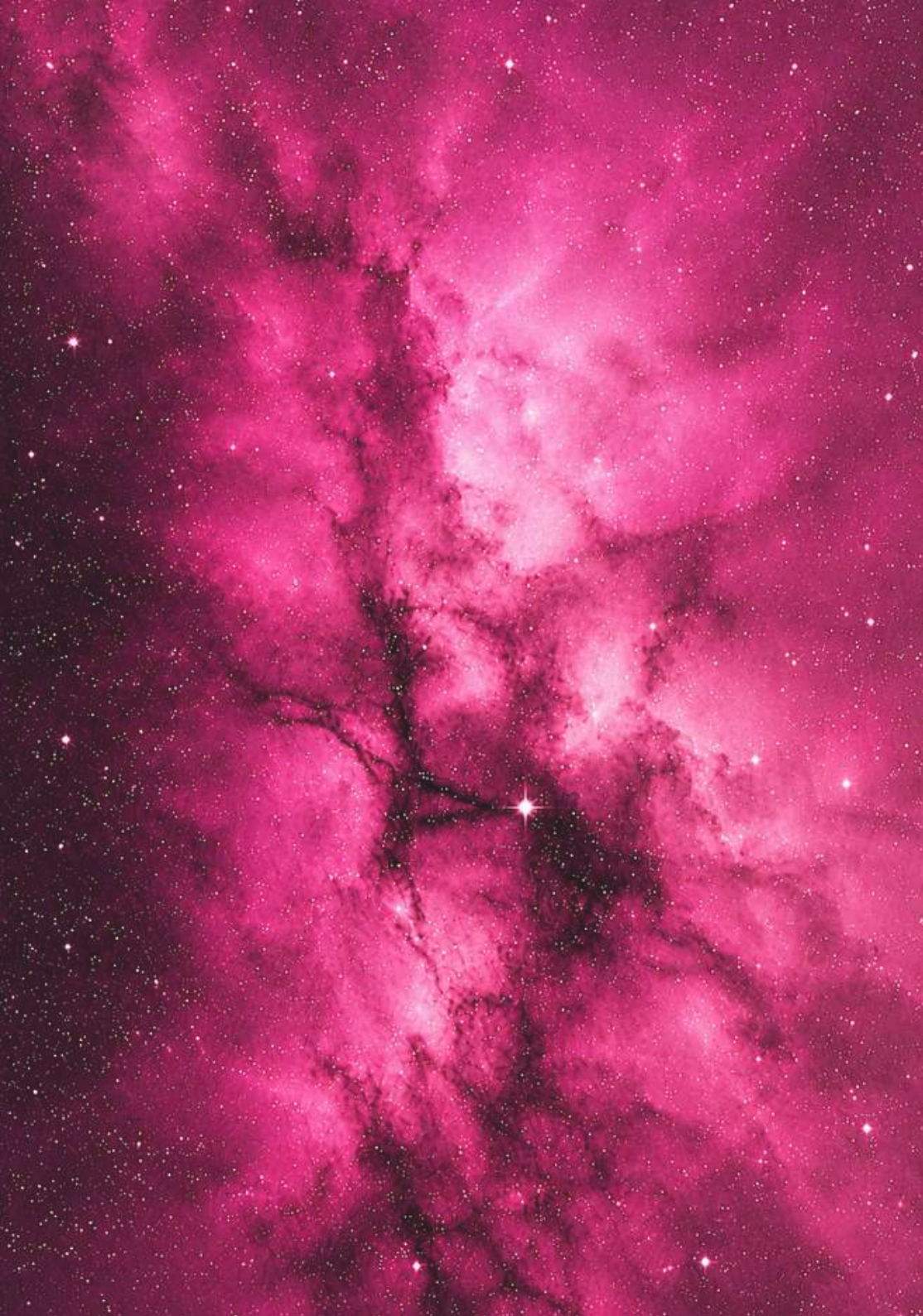

B. Speaking Order

- Each speaker from each team shall first deliver a primary speech and then respond to the rebuttal.
- Each speaker shall speak **ONLY ONCE**.
- Rebuttal questions shall be in the form of short and precise questions raised by opposing team's members based **ONLY** on the content brought up by the speakers during their primary speech.
- Each speaker will only be permitted to speak during his/her allocated time slot. They cannot speak in the time allotted to their partner.

C. Speaking Time

- The speaking time for each speaker is **1½ minutes**. A warning bell shall be sounded at the end of **1 minute** and a final double bell at the end of **1½ minutes**, following which the speaker must conclude.
- Rebuttal time per speaker is **2 minutes**.

D. General Rule of Round 1

- Participants will be judged as a team. For example: Combined scores of Participant 1 & Participant 2 of Contingent X shall be considered for qualification to the next round. No additional preparation time shall be given on the day of the event for Round 1.

FAQs

FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

1. What is a CC Code?

The Cascade Contingent Code (CC Code) is a unique identifier assigned to each school to ensure confidentiality.

2. What is the reporting time for the contingents on the two days?

The reporting time on 22nd and 23rd August is 7:30 am. **ONLY** students of STD. 1 and 2 will be permitted to enter the school 1 hour prior to the scheduled time of their events.

3. How do we get our Cascade ID Cards?

Cascade ID cards must be collected Friday, 14th August 2026 between 12:00 pm and 6:00pm from Jamnabai Narsee School by Teacher-In-Charge or Contingent Leader

4. Can the same Teacher-In-Charge ID card be used for different teachers on the two days?

Yes, they can be used by different teachers on both the days of Cascade.

5. What if a choreographer/dance teacher/sports coach wants to accompany the participants?

8 Teacher-In-Charge ID Cards have been provided which can be used by any of the teachers.

6. Can we view the events at Cascade?

Yes, all participants and non-participants with a valid ID will be permitted in the premises. Entry into all venues will be on first come first serve basis. Please note that all classroom events will not have any viewing.

7. When can we leave the event on either days?

Participants can leave once their event ends. However, re-entry will not be permitted.

8. Is a Participant ID Card valid on both the days of Cascade?

All Participant, Contingent Leader and Teacher-In-Charge ID Cards are valid for both days of Cascade.

9. **What if a participant is taking part in multiple events?**

We suggest that the participant keeps at least a two-hour gap between the end of the one event and the start of another. Kindly refer to the schedule while registering for more than one event. Please note that the schedule is subject to change on the days of the event.

10. **How can negative marking for absenteeism be avoided?**

Negative marking for absenteeism can be avoided by informing the administration department while registering the contingent in the morning OR by substituting the participant with a non-participant.

11. **What is the dress code for Cascade?**

The general dress code for Cascade is smart casuals, however, kindly refer to individual events for clothing specifications. Please note that participants must NOT enter the premises in their school uniform or school jersey.

12. **What is the attire for Numero Uno?**

The attire for the event is semi-formal.

13. **What shoes can we wear for events taking place in the Multipurpose Indoor Court and Multipurpose Outdoor Court?**

Only non-marking flat soles can be worn.

14. **Should we wear any protective gear while playing sports?**

Participants of Sports Mania/Informals may wear protective gear such as knee pads and shin guards.

15. **What are the dimensions of the performance stages?**

Main Auditorium: 35ft. x 18ft. x 15ft.

Amphitheatre: 25ft. x 12ft.

Convention Centre: 12ft. x 16.8ft.

DICE Lab: 7.4ft. x 20.5ft.

16. **What are the dimensions of the courts?**

Multipurpose Outdoor Court: 95ft. x 50ft.

Multipurpose Indoor Court: 44ft. x 20ft.

JNIS Outdoor Court: 56ft. x 28ft.

17. What are the sizes of A0 – A5 papers?

A0: 118.9cm x 84.1cm

A1: 84.1cm x 59.4cm

A2: 59.4cm x 42.0cm

A3: 42.0cm x 29.7cm

A4: 29.7cm x 21.0cm

A5: 21.0cm x 14.8cm

18. Do we have to carry our own stationery?

Basic stationery will be provided.

However, please refer to individual events for specifications regarding additional stationery and materials that all participants must carry.

19. What is mixed media?

Mixed media is the use of a mix of different mediums such as acrylic paints, water colours, colour pencils, etc, together.

20. What is an add-on patch?

Additional material like stickers, sequences or ready-made patches that can be stuck on the composition are called add-on patches.

21. What are background props?

Background props are stationary props that act as a set without being used actively in the performance.

22. In what format do we have to submit the music?

All music must be in MP3 format only. Participants must carry 2 pen drives in case of any problem with the playback.

23. What is a minus one track?

A minus one track is a form of pre-recorded music with no vocals.

24. What technical equipment will be provided at Cascade?

Industry-standard sound and lighting equipment will be provided. For all performance-based events, one member from each contingent MUST be present at the tech desk to cue the sound and lighting. Please note that blackouts will not be allowed during performances.

25. **Do we need to carry food?**

We have a fully functional Cafeteria on both the days of Cascade.

Should we carry a first aid kit?

26. We have a fully functional Health Clinic and an ambulance on call, in case of an emergency. However, if any specific medication is required, it is advised to carry your own.

How can fairness and impartiality be ensured throughout the judging process?

27. At Cascade, transparency is maintained by assigning each participating school a unique CC Code, ensuring judges remain unaware of school identities during evaluation.

When can we collect our trophies and certificates?

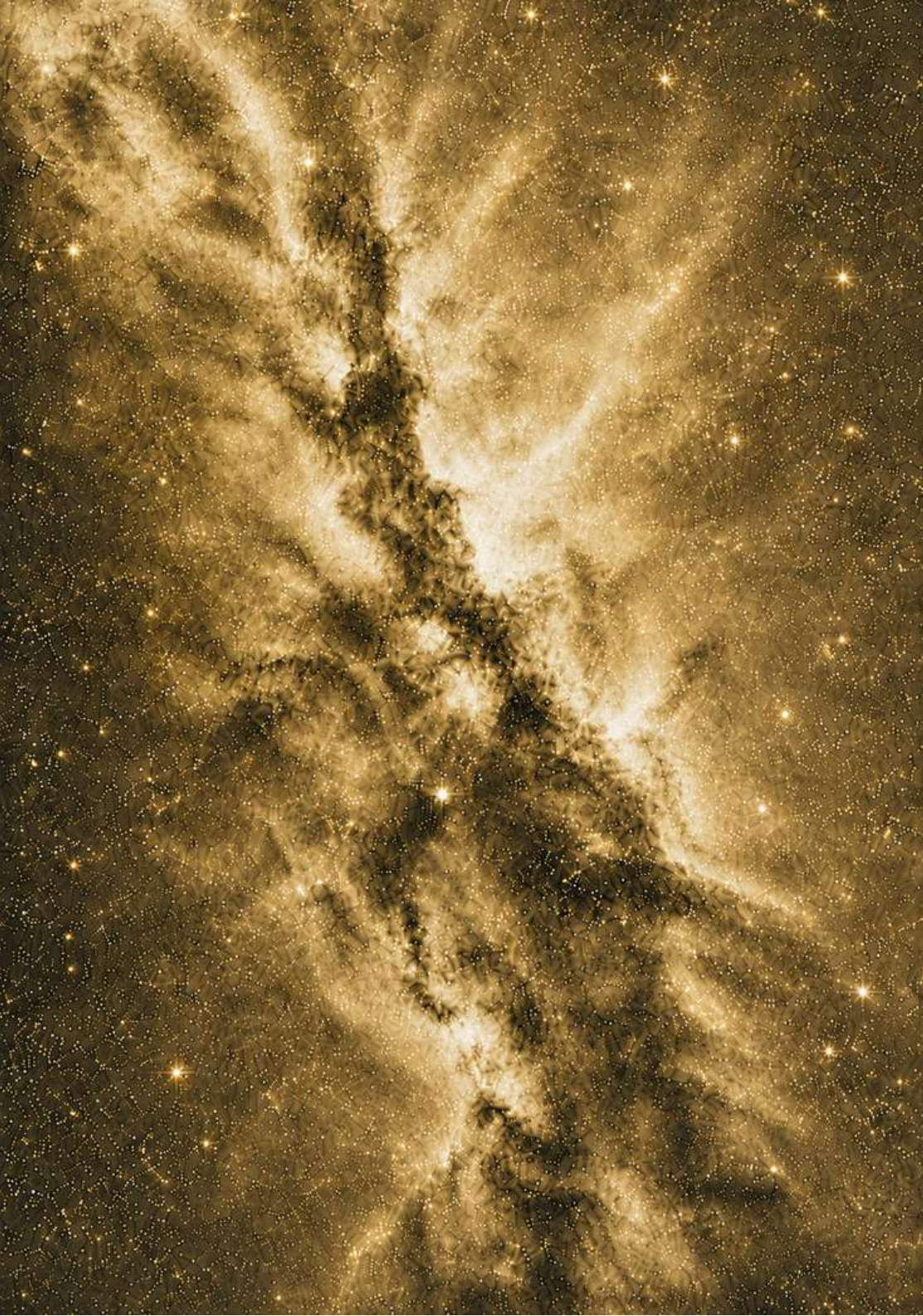
